**THERE ARE MANY TYPES OF TRAFFICKING.**

In East Asia and the Pacific:

- Sexual Exploitation 61%
- Forced Labor 32%
- Other, such as forced begging 7%

**21 MILLION**

**ESTIMATED # OF SEXUAL EXPLOITATION VICTIMS GLOBALLY:**  
**4.5 MILLION**

**1/3** of trafficking victims are children

Most traffickers and their victims  
**SHARE THE SAME ETHNICITY**



**37%** of convicted traffickers are women, and the trend is rising



On average, **EACH VICTIM** of sexual exploitation earns their traffickers **\$21,800 USD** per year



Totalling **\$99 BILLION USD** in illegal annual profits from sexual **EXPLOITATION** around the world.

Since victims can be sold over and over, "business" is lucrative.



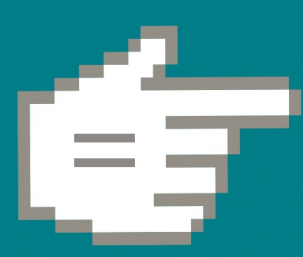
**"Refugees** escaping wars and persecution are easily targeted by traffickers who leverage their desperation to deceive them into exploitation."

**4 OUT OF 5 VICTIMS** within their own region **ARE TRAFFICKED**

**Migrant workers** and **indigenous people** are also particularly vulnerable to trafficking



## DEMAND FOR PORN
